### **President of Dhirubhai Ambani University, Tina Anil Ambani**

Tina Anil Ambani is Chairperson, Group CSR, Reliance Group, where she spearheads sustainability initiatives in the areas of education, healthcare, art and rural transformation.

She is also Chairperson of the Mudra Foundation for Communications Research and Education, which manages MICA, the only residential institute in the Asia-Pacific region dedicated to creating leadership in Strategic Marketing and Communication.

Over the years, Tina Ambani has served on the advisory board of the National Gallery of Modern Art, Mumbai; the National Institute of Design, Ahmedabad; and as nominee to the reconstituted General Assembly of the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR).

She launched the Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital & Medical Research Institute (KDAH) in Mumbai in 2009, India's most advanced quaternary care facility with a unique full-time specialist system, which has succeeded in bringing the world's best technology and treatment protocols to India.

She is credited with setting up the Harmony Art Foundation, an internationally recognised platform dedicated to building relationships with Indian artists, spreading awareness of art, promoting academic activities, including workshops, and international collaborations.

She established Harmony for Silvers Foundation in 2004, a non-government organisation formed to enhance the quality of life of 'Silvers' – Harmony's term for the elderly – in India.

**The President of Dhirubhai Ambani University, has nominated Ambassador T. S. Tirumurti, BoG member, to preside over the 20<sup>th</sup> Convocation**

Ambassador T. S. Tirumurti served in the Indian Foreign Service for nearly four decades from 1985 to 2022, during which he held several distinguished diplomatic and leadership roles. Most notably, he served as India's Ambassador and Permanent Representative to the United Nations in New York from 2020 to 2022 and presided over the United Nations Security Council in August 2021.

Prior to this, he served as Secretary in the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India, with responsibility for Arab countries, Africa, development partnerships, and international economic relations. His overseas diplomatic assignments included Cairo, Geneva, Gaza, Washington D.C., and Jakarta. He served as India's High Commissioner to Malaysia from 2013 to 2018 and was India's first Representative to the Palestinian Authority in Gaza from 1996 to 1998.

At the Ministry of External Affairs in New Delhi, Ambassador Tirumurti handled key portfolios relating to India's neighbouring countries including Bhutan, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Myanmar, and Maldives, and led the United Nations Division. He also served as India's principal negotiator on climate change issues for several years.

Mr Tirumurti is currently a Member of the Board of Governors of DAU in Gandhinagar, Distinguished Professor at the Indian Institute of Technology Madras, and Chair of the Steering Committee, Deccan Centre for International Relations, Chennai. He is also an author, having written three books.

**Prof. (Dr.) Tathagata Bandyopadhyay, Director General,  
Dhirubhai Ambani University**

Prof. Tathagata Bandyopadhyay is an eminent academic, statistician, and higher education leader with an illustrious career spanning teaching, research, and institutional leadership. He holds a PhD in Statistics from the University of Calcutta and has previously served as Dean (Faculty) and Professor at the Indian Institute of Management Ahmedabad.

With extensive international exposure, he has held visiting and teaching positions at leading universities across the United States, Canada, Europe, and Asia. A prolific researcher, Prof. Bandyopadhyay has authored over 70 research publications in reputed national and international journals. He served as Editor of the Calcutta Statistical Association Bulletin from 2009 to 2023 and has been associated with the editorial boards of several prestigious journals.

Prof. Bandyopadhyay has supervised numerous doctoral scholars and has played a significant role in doctoral research committees at premier institutions. As Director General of Dhirubhai Ambani University, he provides academic leadership and strategic direction, fostering excellence in teaching, research, and institutional development.

## **Chief Guest- Prof. Bhaskar Ramamurthi**



Professor Bhaskar Ramamurthi is a distinguished academic leader and technologist with exemplary contributions to higher education, advanced research, and national technology initiatives. He obtained his B.Tech in Electronics from Indian Institute of Technology Madras in 1980, followed by an M.S. (1982) and Ph.D. (1985) in Electrical Engineering from the University of California Santa Barbara. After a brief professional

engagement with AT&T Bell Laboratories, he joined the faculty of IIT Madras in 1986 and has remained deeply associated with the institution ever since.

He served as Director of IIT Madras from 2011 to 2021, providing visionary leadership during a decade marked by significant academic expansion, strengthened research culture, and robust industry engagement. He held the Zoho Chair Professorship in the Department of Electrical Engineering and is currently Professor Emeritus in the same department.

Professor Ramamurthi's academic and research expertise lies in Communications and Signal Processing. His work spans Wireless Networks, Modulation, Wireless Data, and Audio and Video Compression. He heads the Centre of Excellence in Wireless Technology at the IIT Madras Research Park, focusing on emerging wireless standards and next-generation technologies. He holds several patents related to 4G and 5G technologies and served as the National Coordinator for India's end-to-end 5G Test Bed initiative.

He is a Fellow of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) and the Indian National Academy of Engineering (INAE), a Member of the US National Academy of Engineering, and an Honorary Fellow of RWTH Aachen University, Germany. His contributions extend beyond academia to national policy, standards development, and industry leadership.
